
You are now an Office 365 E3 customer and you can leverage all the Microsoft enterprise-grade services to improve productivity, collaboration and communication in your Office.

Office 365 gives you virtually anywhere access to the latest Office applications, enterprise-grade cloud services and advanced IT capabilities.

- Use the complete **Office Suite up to 5 PC or Mac** and **access your documents anywhere** through mobile devices thanks to **Office Mobile** for Windows Phone, iPhone or Android phones or thanks to the **Office Web Apps** via your browser.
- Keep everyone connected with **business-class email and calendars** they can access and share from virtually anywhere.
- **Collaborate** on docs with teammates, **share** reports with business partners, connect with customers, store and sync files with your desktop thanks to **team sites and project management tools**.
- **Host effective online meetings** with multi-party HD video conferencing, real-time note taking, and screen sharing.
- Transform the way you work, find experts in your company with **Enterprise Social Networking**.
- Manage easily your services with your **unified admin portal**. Our **security controls** give you options to customize your security features depending on your specific needs.


Among many benefits available to you, Office 365 gives more to your users!

Give them a personal access to their professional data, information & documents wherever they are. As an integral part of Office 365, SkyDrive Pro lets you work within the context of your organization. SkyDrive Pro makes it easy it to **work with your documents** in SharePoint – **save, sync, share and collaborate** are all drop-dead simple. The name conveys the simplicity and increased consistency with our SkyDrive consumer cloud service while reinforcing the “Pro” features of SharePoint like social networking, collaboration, search, metadata, workflow and compliance. Click “Sync” on a SharePoint library and you will get the documents offline in the Windows Explorer, Office applications and more. SkyDrive Pro is part of both the SharePoint service in Office 365 and server.

This will also an enterprise grade alternative to unmanaged solution like Dropbox.


- **Store your work documents and related files**

If you’re using Office 365, you get **25 GB** of space in the cloud for SkyDrive Pro and related site content. All files that you store in SkyDrive Pro are private initially – only you can see them – unless you decide to share them. You can easily share a file or a document with everyone in your organization by inviting people in your organization to view or edit a document or a folder, and by granting those people viewing or editing permission. If you’re using Office 365, you may be able to share documents and folders with people outside your organization.



- **Collaborate on documents in SkyDrive Pro**

You can collaborate on documents you store in SkyDrive Pro by sharing them with selected people, and granting them editing permission. Likewise, others can invite you to collaborate on documents stored in their SkyDrive Pro libraries.



- **Manage document versions in SkyDrive Pro**

If you have document versioning turned on in SkyDrive Pro, you can view or restore previous versions of documents. If document versioning is turned off, you can still restore the previous version of a document, though only the most recently edited version.

- **Sync SkyDrive Pro to your computer**

The SkyDrive Pro sync application lets you synchronize your SkyDrive Pro library or other SharePoint site libraries to your local computer. This client application is available with Office 2013 or with Office 365 subscriptions that include Office 2013 applications.

- **Use the SkyDrive Pro app on an iPhone or iPad New!**

If your organization uses SkyDrive Pro for cloud storage, you can install the SkyDrive Pro app from the Apple App Store so that you can upload, browse, and share work files with your iPhone or iPad.

- **Use the SkyDrive Pro app in Windows 8 New!**
Use the SkyDrive Pro app in Windows 8 to store, access, and share work documents and other files in the cloud.

Why activate Skydrive Pro now?

Why and how to deploy Skydrive Pro?

Step1: Give the whole company access to Skydrive Pro by attributing to your users an Office 365 ID. All your employee will automatically have access to their personal 25 GB online storage to store documents online and made it accessible everywhere.


Step2: Every user can personalize their page (name, job title, competencies, picture, tags). They could follow the people, the documents, the topics and the pages which are important to them. They will track changes made to documents, information posted by their colleagues or updates on project pages. Everything will appears in the Newsfeed. A strong way to develop interaction between people, to search experts within the organization and to share ideas, documents and information.


Step3: Synchronization with the computer to work on or offline everywhere. The SkyDrive Pro sync application lets you synchronize your SkyDrive Pro library or other SharePoint site libraries to your local computer. This client application is available with Office 2013 or with Office 365 subscriptions that include Office 2013 applications.

Sync your SkyDrive Pro library to your computer:


1. In a web browser, sign in to Office 365 or SharePoint.
2. Select SkyDrive at the top of the page to go to your SkyDrive Pro library.




3. Select Sync at the top of the page.



3. At the prompt, click Sync Now to open the SkyDrive Pro wizard. The wizard automatically fills in the name and web address of your SkyDrive Pro library.
4. Select Sync Now in the wizard to start syncing. You can click Show my files... in the wizard to open the synced SkyDrive Pro library folder in File Explorer. The folder is listed in your Favorites with the name "SkyDrive Pro" or "SkyDrive @ CompanyName."



You can also start the wizard from the SkyDrive Pro menu in your Windows notification area. Select the SkyDrive Pro icon and then select Sync a new library.



If you have yet to sync any SharePoint libraries to your computer, the Sync Library wizard automatically prompts you to sync your SkyDrive Pro library, and references its web address.




If you want to sync a different library, click Sync a different library instead and then enter the web address of the SharePoint library you want to sync.


If you've already synced at least one other library, the wizard prompts you to specify the address of the library you now want to sync.

Sync a site library to your computer:

The simplest way to sync a site library is to sign in to Office 365 or SharePoint, visit the site library you want to sync, and then click Sync at the top of the page.



This opens the SkyDrive Pro wizard, which automatically fills in the name and web address of the site library. Click Sync Now to start syncing the library. Click Show my files... in the dialog box to open the synced library folder in File Explorer. In File Explorer, the synced library folder is placed in the SharePoint folder. The synced library folder uses the name of the site library.
