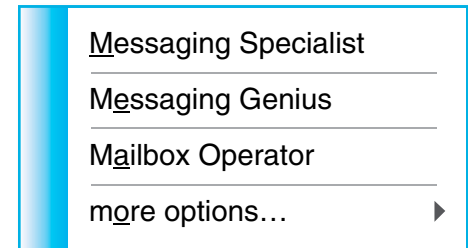

Successful candidates will pass 1 exam focusing on gathering requirements for a messaging infrastructure, designing a messaging infrastructure, designing and validating a messaging continuity-of-operation and disaster recovery plan, creating and maintaining messaging operational procedures and guidelines, managing the messaging environment lifecycle, implementing a messaging infrastructure, mentoring peers by sharing messaging experience and knowledge, and troubleshooting escalated messaging issues.
