

## HP DeskJet 995ck Bluetooth Connections

You can use the Microsoft® Wireless Transceiver for Bluetooth® to connect your HP DeskJet 995ck printer and your computer. For this to work correctly, you must first configure the computer and printer to communicate with each other.

These instructions assume that:

- You have already set up and configured your Microsoft Wireless Transceiver for Bluetooth on your computer.
- You have assembled your printer according to the enclosed printer setup guide.
- You are running Microsoft Windows® XP with Service Pack 2 installed.

### To install your HP DeskJet printer

- 1 Click **Start**, and then click **Printers and Faxes**.
- 2 Under **Printer Tasks**, click **Add a printer**.
- 3 In the Add Printer Wizard, click **Next**.
- 4 Click **A Bluetooth printer**, and then click **Next**.

Your computer will search for new Bluetooth devices. When your computer detects the printer, the Bluetooth light on the left corner of the printer will flash.

- 5 Follow the instructions in the wizard to install the printer driver. If the Add Printer Wizard locates more than one appropriate printer driver, select the first driver in the list.
- 6 During installation, the Hewlett-Packard installation wizard will appear. When you are prompted, print a test page to verify a successful Bluetooth connection.

### Troubleshooting Tips

If the Add Printer Wizard is having problems detecting your printer, click **Back** in the Add Printer Wizard and search for the printer again. It might take two or three tries for Windows to first detect your new printer.

If you are still having problems, try connecting the printer by using the enclosed cable first to verify that the printer is working correctly. After the printer is properly configured, you can try again to set it up by using a Bluetooth connection.
