In launching Azure Government Secret, delivering both security and innovation is our priority.

We will partner with any U.S Government entity with classified data requirements who can provide us an accreditation and classified network connection.

Q: What are the controls the U.S. Government requires Microsoft to have in place for Secret?

DoD Impact Level 6 (IL6) is what we plan to accredit to. For Secret, IL6 represents the most stringent level of required controls.

Q: Why is Microsoft doing this?

To best support U.S. Government mission needs we aim to provide the full spectrum of Azure capabilities to all levels of government data requirements.
