


Ipsos Mori Methodology

Ipsos MORI interviewed 5,555 employees of SMBs (Small to Medium-sized Businesses) in the following countries: Great Britain, Poland, Spain, the Netherlands, the Czech Republic, Denmark, Italy, Belgium, Sweden, Switzerland, Hungary, Romania, Ukraine, Greece, Norway and



Finland.

All participants fulfilled three key criteria: they worked for companies which were headquartered in these countries, they used some form of mobile computing and/or a computer at their place of work and they worked for companies that employ 250 people or fewer. Interviews were conducted online via the Ipsos Interactive panel between 9th January and 9th February 2015. Data are unweighted.



Makes me more productive when out of the office




Those who use an employer-owned device for work say they use it for social networking, gaming, online shopping or personal email.
