

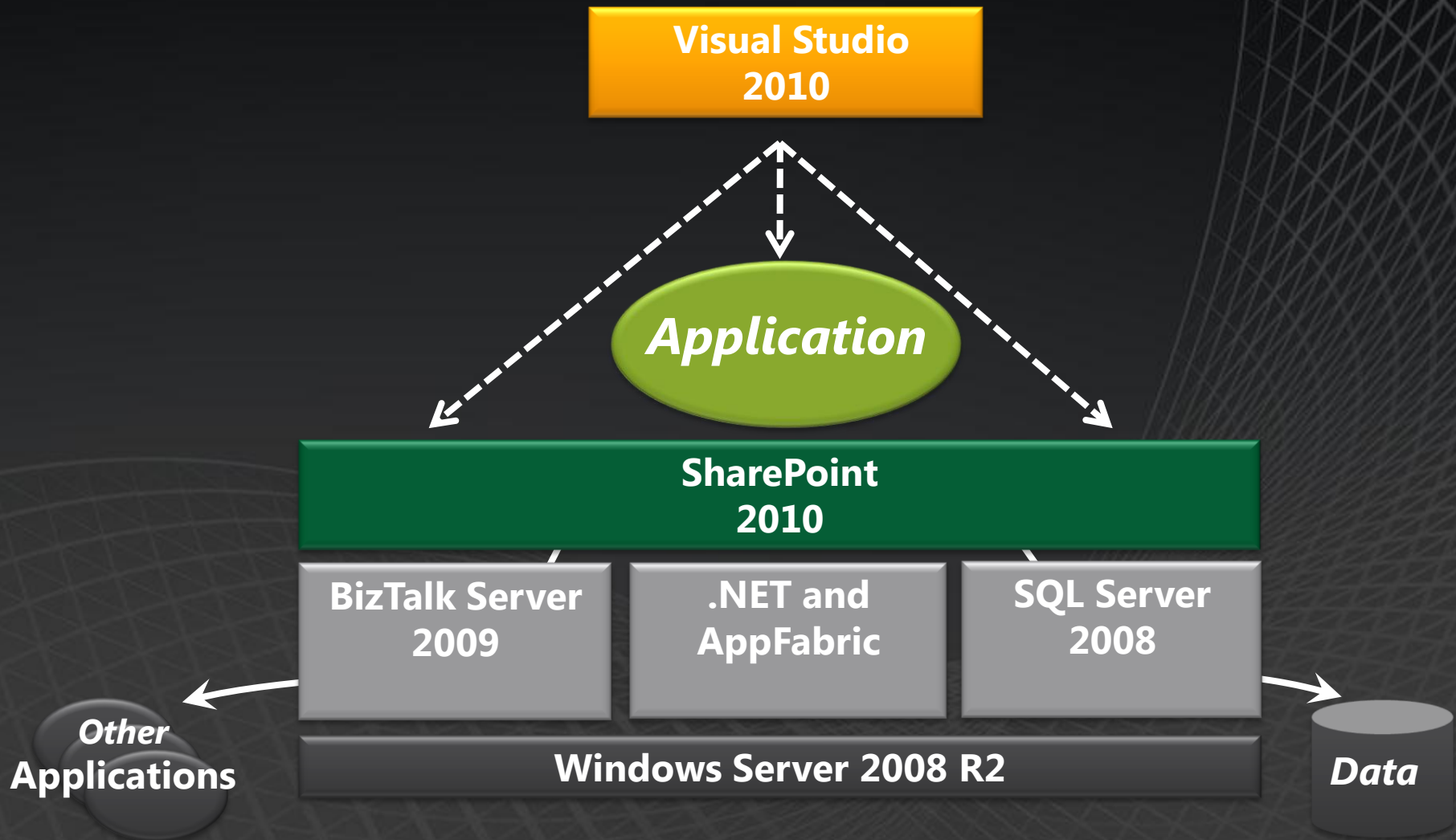

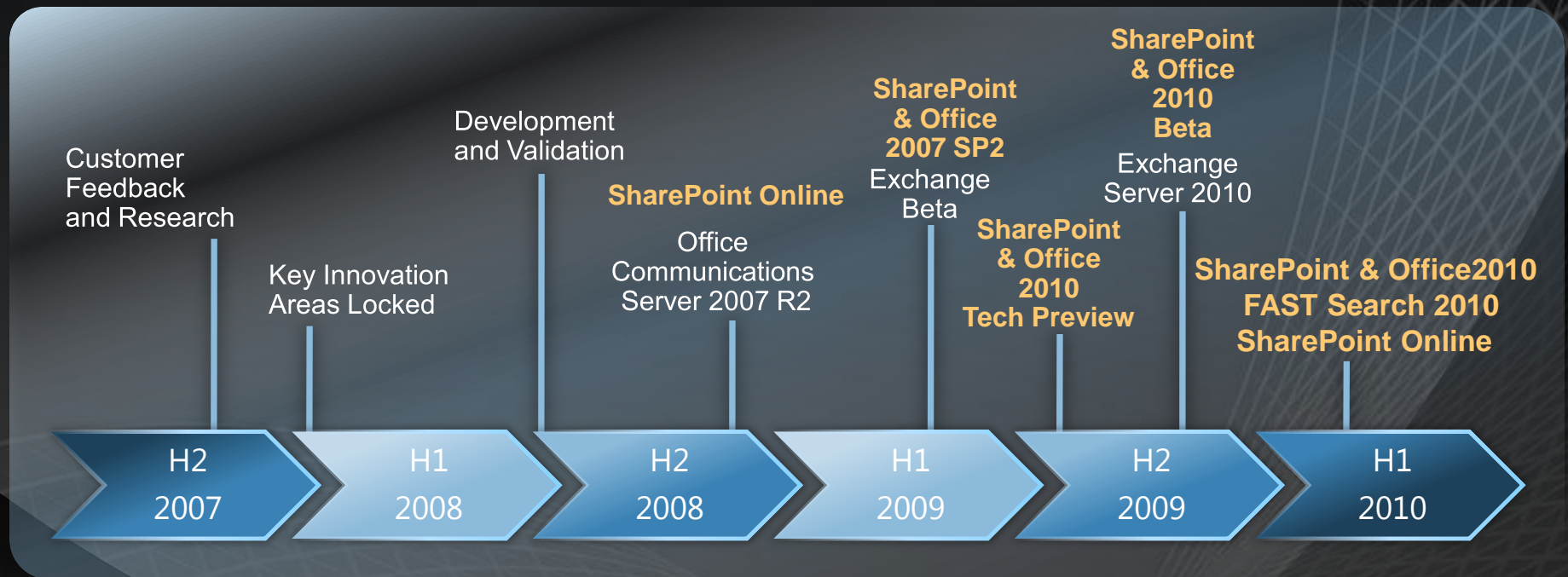

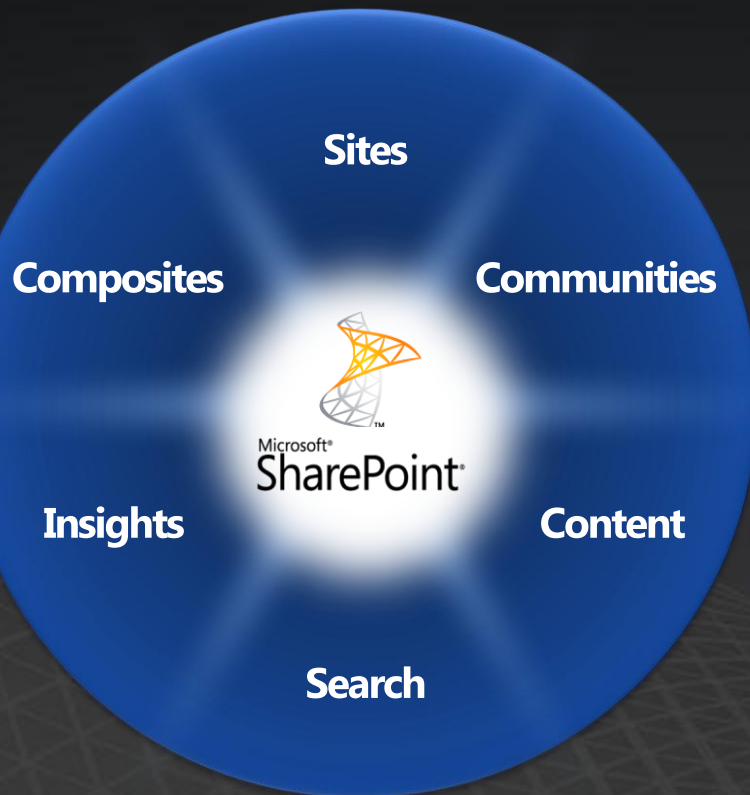
SharePoint and Office 2010 Timeline

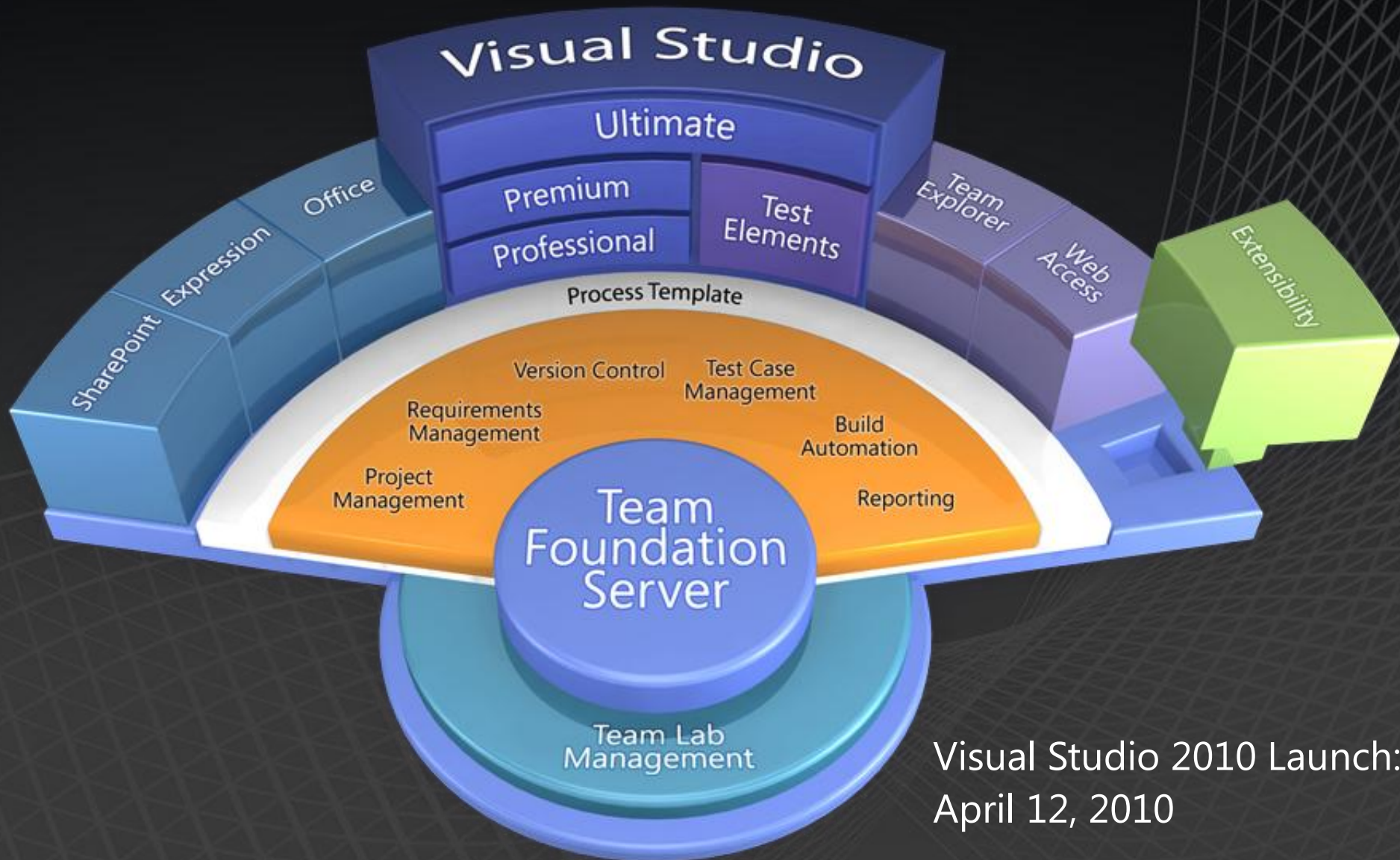

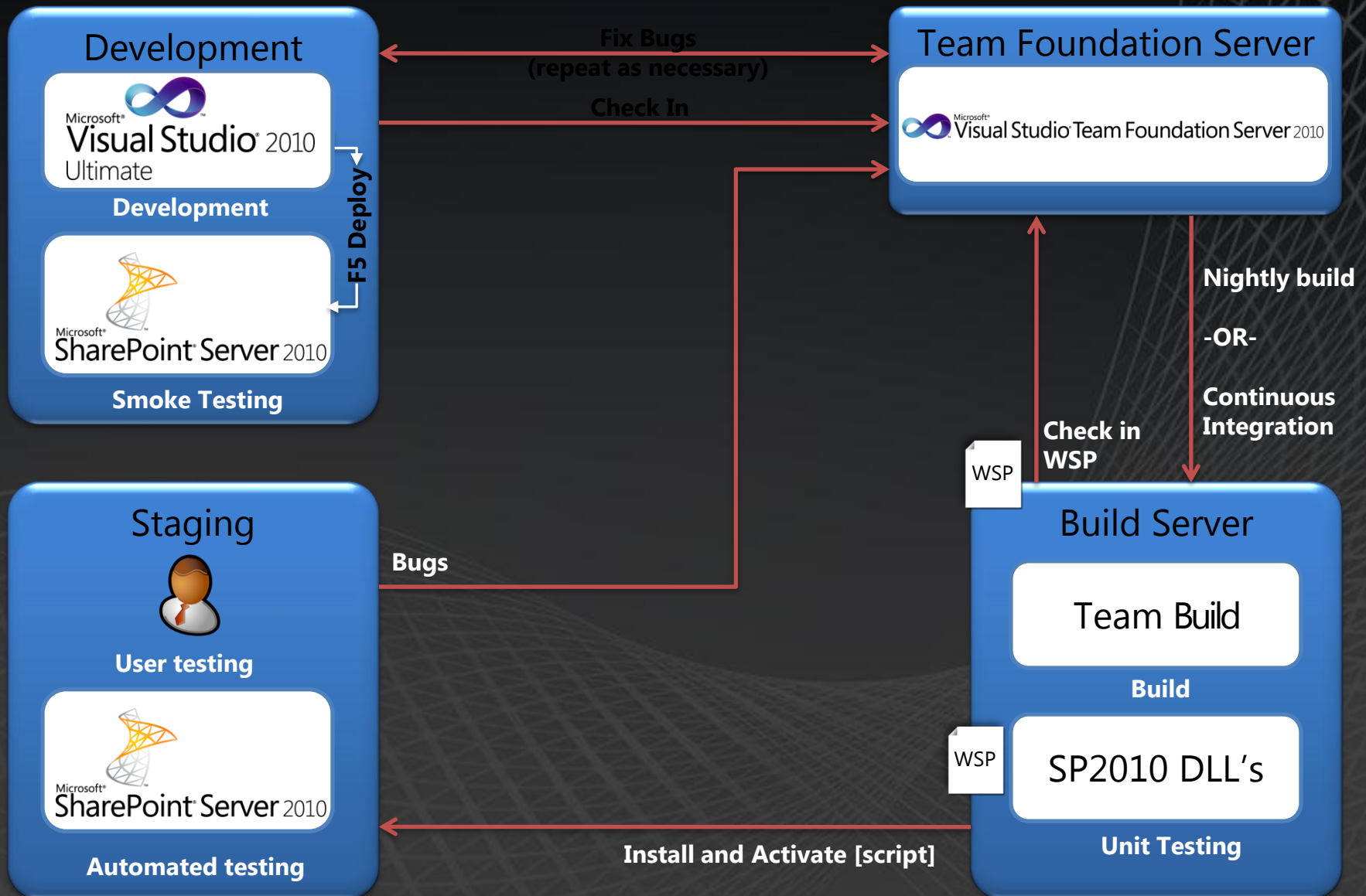


Application Lifecycle Management (ALM)
