How to show and hide the input panel

1. To show or hide the selected input method, tap Input on the command bar.



Entering Information on your device:

How to change the input method

1. Tap the Input arrow and select a new input method.

Tip: To change the options for any input method, tap Options.



Entering Information on your device:

How to use the soft keyboard

1. Tap the Input arrow and then Keyboard.
 - To type lowercase letters, tap the keys.
 - To type a single uppercase letter or symbol, tap the Shift key. To tap multiple uppercase letters or symbols, tap the CAP key.
 - To convert a letter to uppercase, tap and hold the stylus on the letter and drag up.
 - To add a space, drag the stylus to the right across at least two keys.
 - To backspace one character, drag the stylus to the left across at least two keys.
 - To insert a carriage return, tap and hold the stylus anywhere on the keyboard and drag down.

Tip: If you want to use larger keys, tap the Input arrow, Options, select Keyboard in Input method, and then select Large Keys.



Entering Information on your device:

How to use Block Recognizer

Character recognition software gives you a fast and easy method for entering information in any program on your device. Letters, numbers, and punctuation you write are translated into typed text.

1. To use character recognition, tap the Input arrow and then Block Recognizer. For help with writing characters, tap the question mark near the writing area.



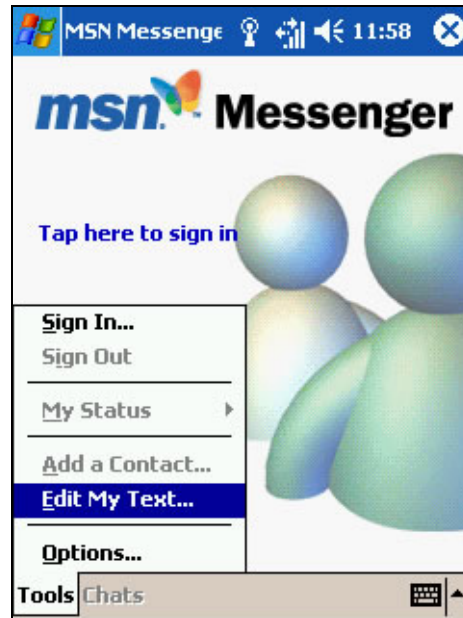

How to use My Text

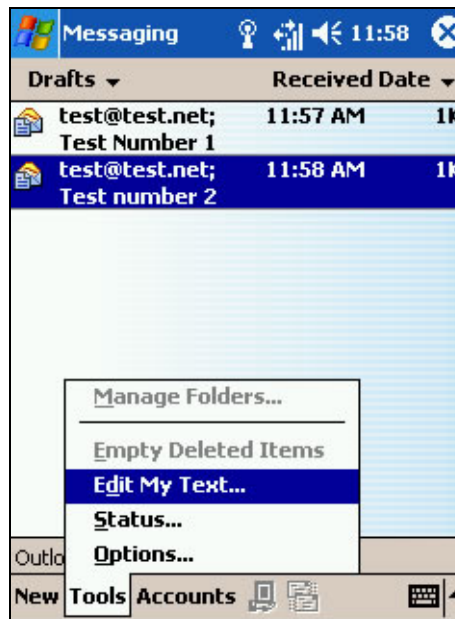
My Text is available in Messaging and MSN Messenger and provides a fast, easy way to add common sentences to your messages.



1. To quickly add common messages, tap My Text and tap a desired message.



2. To edit a My Text message in MSN Messenger, tap Tools > Edit My Text. Tap the message you want to edit and enter new text at the bottom of the screen.



3. To edit a My Text message in the message list in Messaging, tap Tools > Edit My Text. Tap the message you want to edit and enter new text at the bottom of the screen.



4. To edit a My Text message in an e-mail message in Messaging, tap Tools > Edit My Text. Tap the message you want to edit and enter new text at the bottom of the screen.
