Microsoft understands the challenges inherent in today's enterprise computing environments, and has responded with best-in-class technology accompanied by proven best practices for operating and managing that technology.

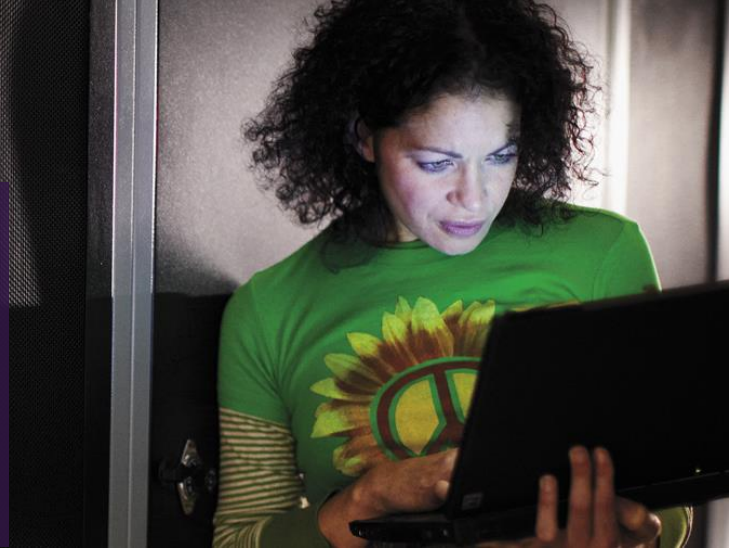
MOF Foundations Workshop
