Add Project Online to your Office 365 account

- 1. Log on to your Office 365 Enterprise or Academic account.
- 2. On the Office 365 admin center click Purchase Services.



3. Click Add

next to the Project Online plan that you prefer, and follow the on-screen instructions.

After signing up, be patient!



It takes a while for Project Online to finish getting set up. Setup will generally be done within 30 minutes to an hour.


- ► First, create Office 365 user accounts for the people you're adding.

Create Office 365 user accounts


- 1. In the Office 365 admin center, click Users and Groups.
- 2. Click + at the top of the list of users.
- 3. Follow the on-screen instructions.

Share the Project Online site

- 1. From your Project Online site, click Share.
- 2. Type the name of the new user.
- 3. Click **Show Options** and choose:
 - Whether to send the person an email invitation.
 - What **permissions** you want the person to have in Project Online. Permissions determine what the person will and will not be able to do.






