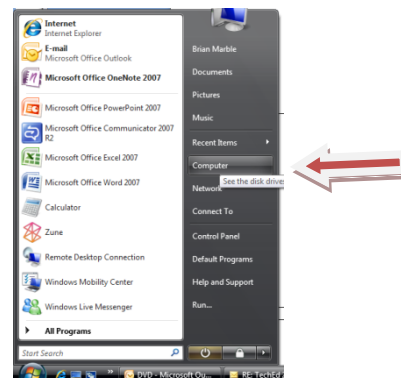

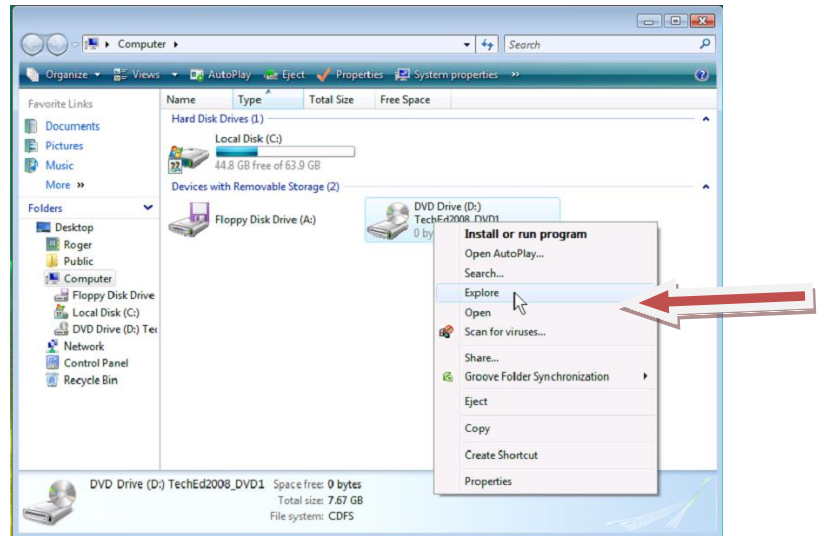

Step 1: From the start menu click on "Computer"

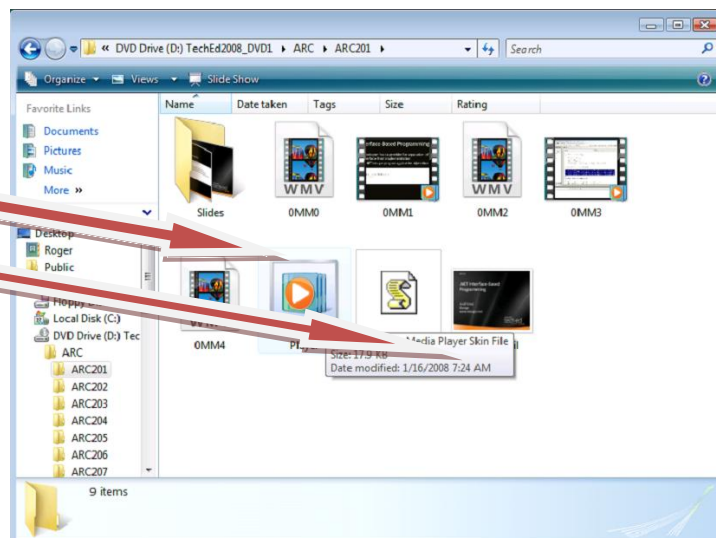


Step 2: Right click the DVD and select “Explore” from the option menu
