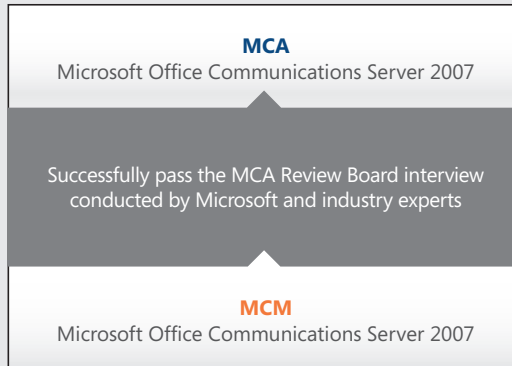
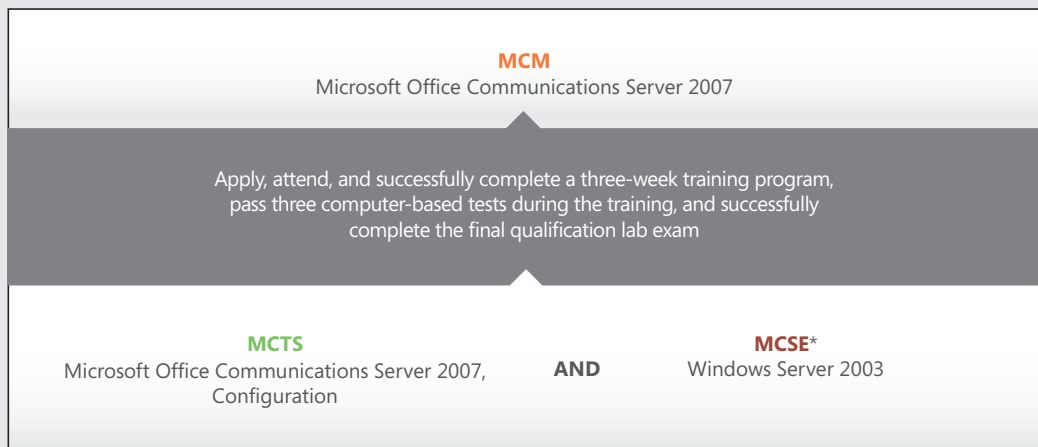

PATHS TO BECOME A MICROSOFT CERTIFIED ARCHITECT (MCA)

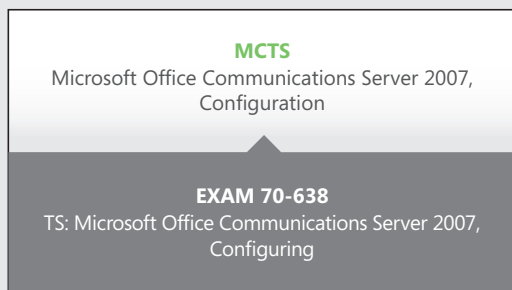


PATHS TO BECOME A MICROSOFT CERTIFIED MASTER (MCM)
